








## Age Breakdown For Locality of Palmer Heights










## **Adult Education Level** For Locality of Palmer Heights







## **School Expenditures** FOR EASTON AREA SCHOOLS








## **Housing Characteristics** For Neighborhood Within Locality of Palmer Heights










**Temperature** Measured at ALLENTOWN AIRPORT, PA (elevation = 388ft.)








## Age Breakdown **For Northampton County**




